Travel to Ravensburg

The closest airport to Ravensburg is Friedrichshafen; from there it is 20 minutes to Ravensburg with a commuter train running every hour. Other suitable airports with good railroad connections to Ravensburg are located in Stuttgart, Zurich, Munich and Memmingen (served by budget airlines such as Ryanair). <https://www.bahn.com/en/view/index.shtml>
