Moreover, being able to enrol for the Final Dissertation depends on various aspects as well as the resources of the departments and it cannot be guaranteed for all exchange students.

Language requirements. Completing a Dissertation requires a certain level of English language skills, especially in academic writing. The minimum level of English language skills is B1 on the CEFR scale. Students applying for a final project must submit a certificate stating the level of their English language skills.
